

Be In God's Stream

Open with prayer to God for wisdom.

If you throw a jagged rock into a shallow, swift stream and wait long enough, that rock will be found smooth, shaped by the constant pressure of rushing water flowing around it all the time. The rock has become a product of the stream to which it now belongs. We are all imperfect, with jagged edges, in some way that is against the will of Christ, and we must put ourselves into that stream, endure the pressures of His guiding condemnation, wisdom, and mighty plan He has for us. With time, we lose our jagged edges and are made into a people that belong in His stream, in His life for us. Still, we are the ones who must choose to put ourselves into His stream, His will, His pressures, come what may.

Read Psalm 66:8-16
