Open with prayer for God's wisdom

There was a fog advisory here in Cypress, Texas, this morning. The fog was dense, and visibility on the road was around 0.5 miles - not really bad, but enough to notice. It's important to know where we are, where we're going, and what's ahead of us as best we can. Paul tells us that the visibility we have of ourselves, every aspect of who we truly are and can be, is the same as being in a fog. Our sight is limited. When we choose to believe in Jesus Christ, our visibility improves. However, we will remain in some amount of a fog the rest of our lives on earth until we pass away. As verse 12 tells us, we only see in part at this time. On the day we join Him in heaven, the fog is finally lifted, and we can see to the horizon, so to speak. Christ has a glorious plan for you, and the only way you can see it is to put your faith in Him.

Read 1 Corinthians 13
